

## The Pill Progestogen-only (POP) Instructions for Use

Start your pill on .....

Take a pill every day until the pack is finished.

On the next day, start your new pack.

Do not have a break

It is important that you take your pill at the <b>same time</b> every day.
You will be contraceptively safe after taking
pills. Use a condom or do not have sexual intercourse until then.
You may not be protected from
pregnancy if you
• miss a pill or take it more than hours after
the normal time
• vomit within 3 hours of taking your pill or
have continued vomiting
• have diarrhoea (several loose bowel motions).
If any of these things happen
• continue taking the pill
<ul> <li>use another method of contraception such</li> </ul>
as condoms or do not have sexual intercourse
for the <b>next</b>

All pills are hormone pills. If you stop taking them every day, you may become pregnant.

Your periods may be regular on this pill. However, some women have irregular bleeding or no bleeding at all.

If you miss a period for 6 weeks, contact your health professional for advice.

If you have unprotected sexual intercourse contact a Family Planning Clinic or your doctor for emergency contraception within 72 hours (24 hours if possible). The sooner the better.

Condoms help protect against sexually transmissible infections.
