Medical examinations for New Zealand visa applicants

Immigration New Zealand is changing the way it carries out medical examinations for visa applicants in New Zealand.


At the moment, a visa applicant can complete their immigration medical examination with any registered doctor in New Zealand.

Immigration New Zealand is now moving to a new system called eMedical, and specific medical and radiology clinics have been selected to complete immigration medicals.

From 31 March 2015, visa applicants in New Zealand can:

- complete their immigration medical examination at one of the eMedical or radiology clinics on Immigration New Zealand's onshore panel, listed on the website
- have a look at Immigration New Zealand's website
 www.immigration.govt.nz/healthinfo for information
 to support them with their immigration medical
 examination appointment.

There will be a transition period until 30 June 2015, where applicants may have a paper medical certificate completed by any registered New Zealand physician.
